Photos should be high resolution. Applications must be received by Thursday, April 18, 2024, 11:59 pm CST. Applications must be typewritten to be considered. We will not accept handwritten applications. This form is a fillable PDF. Incomplete application packages missing any of the information required will not be considered. Late applications, including late transcripts or late references, will not be considered. Contact your references as soon as possible to let them know you are using them as a reference and to expect an email from pearlsfoundation.scholarships@gmail.com.
- HBCU applicants are required to remit their most recent official college transcript with an unbroken seal, postmarked by April 18, 2024, and mailed to **PEARLS Foundation**, **Attn: Scholarships**, **P.O. Box 56005**, **Little Rock**, **AR 72215**.
- Nikeba R. Davis Excellence in the Arts Scholarship applicants will be required to submit samples of their creative work as part of the application process. Dr. Phillis Nichols-Anderson Faith-Based Book Scholarship

Phillis Nichols Anderson Faith-Based Book Scholarship applicants must be of African American ethnicity; must be 2024 high school graduates from a high school in Pulaski, Faulkner, Conway, or Pope Counties, and must be planning to enroll in a higher education program for the Fall 2024 semester. Applicants must have received their high school diploma by that time. Eligible higher education programs include two- or four-year colleges or universities; community colleges; technical, vocational, or business schools; or any other type of higher education licensed by the state of Arkansas or any other state or federal entity.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

One \$1000 scholarship and one \$750 scholarship will be awarded to two deserving 2024 high school graduates for the *Phillis Nichols-Anderson Faith-Based Scholarship*.

Theta Mu Chapter and meet the criteria for active membership according to the most current revision of the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., Theta Mu Chapter bylaws; and must be classified as a junior or senior and had at least three (3) active semesters of membership in the chapter since their initiation at the time of consideration. Consideration will be given to financial need.

Moreover, candidates for the *Undergraduate Excellence in Action Scholarship* must have maintained no lower than a 2.8 cumulative grade-point average or equivalent; and must have demonstrated the following: attainment of academic achievement metrics as determined by Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority active status, community service as evidenced by proof of 50 hours or more of community service, chapter leadership as evidenced by serving as a chapter officer and/or committee chairman, evidence of campus leadership, and participation in Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority's programmatic initiatives and beyond.

HBCU applicants must be of African American ethnicity, must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or above, and must be in good standing with their college or university.

One \$1000 scholarship and one \$750 book scholarship will be awarded to two college students currently attending one of Arkansas' Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU).
